Blair School of Music Holdings

- 5000+ items held in multiple formats
 - Reel-to-reels (different types)
 - Cassette tapes
 - DAT tapes
 - CDs
 - DVDs
- approx. 800 new recordings deposited annually by Blair Technical Services

Blair School of Music

- How were things handled before?
 - Recordings were stored in different locations across campus
 - Blair Technical Services (beneath the Ingram Concert Hall)
 - Faculty offices
 - Music Rehearsal Building
 - No one organizational scheme dominated
 - People did not know what we had nor where to find it

What to do?

Development of:

The Blair Performance Archive (BPA)

- Goals:
 - Browseable and searchable catalog
 - Online streaming access to sound files
 - Digital preservation copies of items
 - Copyright protection/security
 - Be realistic!

The Blair Performance Archive

- Development Methods/Factors
 - Few options for development
 - LITS understaffed
 - Little budget for technology or student workers
 - Staffing time constraints
 - BUT, earlier projects to draw upon:
 - The Global Music Archive
 - Earlier digital library developed by the Blair School of Music, Wilson Music Library, and LITS in 2006

The Blair Performance Archive

- Database structure:
 - Influenced heavily by the Global Music Archive
- Hardware:
 - 1 PC workstation
 - External hard drive (provided by LITS)

- Software:

- User access:

- Web browser
 - Adobe Reader
 - RealMedia Player

- Item processing:

- Adobe Professional
 - SoundForge
 - Helix Production Plus

The Blair Performance Archive

- **Digitization** (where applicable)
 - Funding for digitizing a portion of the Peabody reel-to-reels granted through the Dean's office of the Blair School
 - Outsourced to the Center for Popular Music at Middle Tennessee State University

The Blair Performance Archive

- Metadata structure
 - Controlled headings (certain performers, type of performance, series, etc.)
 - Note: *No* controlled headings for subjects or name/titles
 - Details of recording (date, time, place)
 - Contents (as performed)
 - Classification (for uniform file naming and shelving)
 - Formula derived from format, date, and place
 - Links to sound files and program PDF files

The Blair Performance Archive

- Security/Permissions
 - We had permission from students, faculty, and certain visiting artists to record their performances
 - BUT, we did not have their permission to make this content available on the open web

The Blair Performance Archive

- Security/Permissions
 - Solution:
 - Vanderbilt ID/password-protected access to the database
 - Streaming, non-downloadable digital sound files
 - If a performer specifically requests that their performance not be made accessible:
 - The link to the appropriate sound file is deactivated
 - The item record and the preservation copies are still retained

Timeline

- Process timeline
 - 2008-early 2009
 - Through a plea to faculty and technical services staff, collection of all known recordings held within the Blair School of Music into the Music Library Vault
 - 2009, May
 - Overall metadata structure completed and agreed upon
 - 2009, August
 - Wireframes completed and submitted to LITS
 - 2009, September
 - Digitization of first reel-to-reels
 - 2010, January
 - Database built by Jodie Gambill of LITS based on the structure of the GMA
 - 2010, January—present
 - Populating database (all staff + 1 student)

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Search for:

☰ Search Tips

The Basic Search searches all relevant fields by keyword and returns results ordered by Title. The Boolean operator OR is implied between each word typed unless one or more special search operators are used as described below:

- " (double quotes): searches the words enclosed in double quotes as a phrase
- * (asterisk): truncation; appended to the end of a word
- - (minus sign): excludes the word or phrase from all results
- + (plus sign): requires the word or phrase to be present in all results

Examples:

- **child*** will find *child*, *children*, *child's*, and any other word beginning with child
- **"French horn"** will find items with *French horn* in them (but not *French horns*)
- **Blair -Peabody** will find all recordings from Blair except those that are from Peabody
- **+violin* +clarinet*** will find items with (*violin* or *violins* or *violinist*) AND (*clarinet* or *clarinets* or *clarinetist*)
- **Blair -.Blair String Quartet** will find performances in Blair, but not those by the Blair String Quartet

Issues encountered

- Missing programs
 - Solution: If a student recital, a public note is added to the item record: *Program not submitted.*
- Unknown selections
 - Solution: Efforts are made to identify selections, but [Unknown selection] may be added as a last resort.
- Faulty masters
 - Solution: A public note is added where appropriate.

Future steps

- Further tweaking of metadata and system functionality
- Complete user name/password security features
- Formal launch and publicity
- Add video component for audiovisual files
