

- 4. Performing editions







How Much Space Emory's Historical Sets Take Up

- About 15% of the score collection by number of volumes
- About 28% of the score collection by linear feet

Emory's Music Department

- 1990–2015 master's programs in choral conducting, organ performance, and sacred music
- Around 100 undergraduate, emphasis on liberal arts and music as double major
- Faculty focuses: Baroque, 19th-century, 20th-century, Black music, ethnomusicology, composition, performance (esp. piano and voice), choir, orchestra, and jazz

Circulation Stats Overview, 1994–2020

- 7441 volumes in M1–M3.3
- 3262 (44%) have ever been checked out
- Those 3262 volumes checked out 9964 times
- 5399 (54%) of 9964 checkouts come from volumes checked out 5 times or more



- 2 volumes account for 227 (24%) of checkouts



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
RRIMO Legacy Collection, 1962–2017

Number of Searches on the RRIMO platform at Emory, January 2019—August 2020 (total: 629)




Number of PDF RRIMO Scores Accessed at Emory, January 2019–August 2020 (total: 39)


% of volumes from each publication year checked out by 2017 (data from 2017)
